A special place to take pictures

01. Transfer to Wilson Airport and flight to Amboseli

The most famous shots from African safaris - elephants in front of the volcano Kilimanjaro - taken in Amboseli. This is a photographer's paradise! Apart from the largest population of elephants, Amboseli is famous for the opportunity to see the other animals of the Big Five: buffalo, black rhinos, lions and cheetahs.

02. Elewana Tortilis Camp (for 2 nights)

Elewana Tortilis Camp, set among The camp we chose for a reason: not the best view of Kilimanjaro, but also private access to the private Kithirua Nature Reserve. Under guided by experienced guides, we'll travel to the Elephant swamps and a lake where flamingos live, see antelope and gazelle pastures and a scrubby bush that hides of predators.

Unique animal species


01. Flight To Loisabu

The Loisaba Nature Reserve is located on the The picturesque Laikipia Plateau, stretching along the equator between Mt. Kenya and the Great Rift Valley. It is Here, among the green plains and winding rivers, the endangered reticulated giraffe. The endangered reticulated giraffe, the Grevy's zebra, the wild African dog and the elusive black leopard.

02. Elewana Loisaba Tented Camp (for 2 nights)

We will be staying at Elewana Loisaba Tented Camp, built on the site of historic Loisaba Lodge, but decorated in a modern style. In addition today and overnight safari trips we will Horse and camel rides, river fishing, and lunches and dinners in a bush under the African sky.

Day 5-7

Comfortable conditions

01. Flight to Masai Mara

Camp Kichwa Tembo is located beneath the Olulolo escarpment in the Great Rift Valley. From here you have stunning views of the plains of Kenya's most famous nature reserve - Masai Mara. Every year, at the end of the rainy season, countless herds of antelope and zebra cross it in search for new food.

02. Camp Kichwa Tembo (for 3 nights)

We will live in spacious classic tents with a terrace and a shower. The tents are spaced far enough apart to provide our guests with complete privacy. After your safari, you will be able to relax by the pool or read with a book and soak in the sounds of the wildlife nature.
